Each year, 2.8 million women in the U.S. experience an unexpected pregnancy. The PMC (Pregnancy Medical Clinic), formerly the PCC (Pregnancy Care Center), is a community-funded, faith-based organization serving women in unexpected pregnancies and assisting them as they discover positive alternatives for their difficult situations.

- Pregnancy testing and evidence based options education (129 in 2017)
- Nurse consultations
- First trimester ultrasounds & referrals
- Classes where moms learn to be great parents and receive clothing/ supplies for their baby
- Referrals for women seeking support after an abortion

Great News from the PMC! We've made great progress over the last year and have become a medical clinic specializing in early pregnancy diagnosis, services, and referrals. Last year we changed our name from the PCC to the PMC and moved into a new location in Roy.

Over the last few months we've been able to add ultrasound exams to our medical services in order to better meet the needs of our patients in unexpected pregnancies. Our volunteer Patient Advocates work with our volunteer Clinic Nurses who now provide nursing consultations for patients. Our Nurse Manager has completed training and does in-house ultrasound exams.

All the progress since last year has caused great excitement for "Steps for Life" as walkers joined in and began talking with their friends to help raise the funds needed to cover the additional expenses of our expanded outreach to women.

Even on a rainy, cool spring morning over 75+ friends of the PMC gathered for 2018's "Steps for Life" celebration. Many people toured the new facility to learn more about the PMC while the kids enjoyed a special activity.

For the 31st year in a row Patty M. attended the walk and raised funds to help reach women in difficult situations.

Over the last six weeks our *Steps for Life* walkers have been

gathering funds to cover the PMC outreach and received donations from over 650 sponsors.

There were **106** walkers who participated from **48** area churches. Leading the charge were the PMC staff and Board members who together raised over \$6,000.

Our new facility located at 1937 W 5700 South in Roy

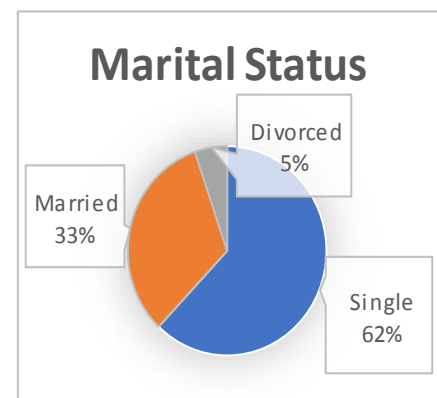
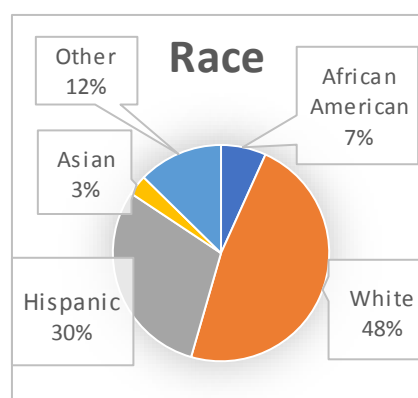
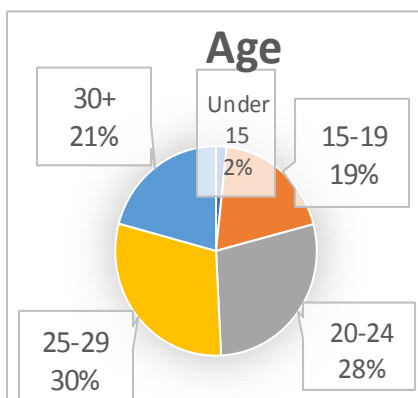
